He explained that he was in discussions with RPS and RBST with regard to wing tagging and a definitive way to tag birds from an early age. Danny suggested that Wing Bands are a good option from an early age until either Wing Tags or Leg Rings can be fitted.

Danny gave his excellent presentation on what to look for when starting with the UK Spanish and important hints and tips. Andy Marshall answered questions and stressed the importance knowing the history of your birds and breeders alike to ensure quality of stock.

Breeding Programme

Paul would like to remind everyone that as we are 1 of the 7 (Target Breeds) involved in Breeding Programs. This will enable our rare breeds to be registered on the new RBST database (free registration) so that in an event of a local case of Avian Flu, your birds **may** be spared. Once they are individually identified and once we are accepted onto the Breeds at Risk Register. Paul will keep us updated.

In the meantime Paul is also in discussion with Poultry Club of Great Britain (PCGB) as the organisers of the UK leg ring scheme who will also be in charge of Wing Tag ordering. We do need to know the number of breeders who would use wing tags and the number of tags they might estimate) for costing order (rough purposes from the supplier. So could you please e-mail Paul as soon as possible with your estimated numbers needed as the meeting in mid January will decide if PCGB will adopt wing tags and decisions need to be made now for the 2021 breeding season.

Census

Those members who have not completed the census form on the UK Spanish website or sent it to Paul, please do so as soon as possible as it is imperative that numbers are registered so that monitoring can be maintained of the UK Spanish breed. This is all done with complete confidentiality.
